

# Prof. Heimburger Award 2025

## Applications are now open!

Since 2008, the Prof. Heimburger Award supports pioneering ideas from the next generation of coagulation specialists in the field of inherited and acquired bleeding disorders

**Five winners will each receive a global research grant of €25,000 and the opportunity to present their research at the annual virtual award ceremony**

### Who is eligible to apply?

- The awards are reserved for researchers who hold a medical degree or a PhD; applicants with less than five years post-doctoral research experience or clinical practice experience will be prioritized
- The awards are available for clinical and preclinical research in the areas of:
  - Inherited bleeding disorders and
  - Acquired bleeding disorders
- Multiple applications for different research proposals by the same applicant in the current award cycle will not be considered
- Matching funds are not a prerequisite for this award
